Rome (2 nights) – Assisi (1 night) – Venice (1 night) – Salzburg (2 nights) –

Oberammergau (2 nights) – Munich (1 night)

Duration:

10 days / 9 nights

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1: Rome arrival

- Arrive to Rome International Airport and meet your local professional tour manager
- Board the coach and transfer to hotel
- Dinner and overnight in Rome

Day 2: Rome

- Breakfast at the hotel
- In the morning we will attend the Papal Audience and receive a Blessing by His Holiness the Pope in St. Peter's Square. (Pending schedule of Pope Francis, subject to change at last moment).
- Lunch on your own.
- In the afternoon, enjoy the tour of imperial city of Rome including Trajan's Market and Forum, Arch of Constantine, the Colosseum.



- Continue to famous monuments of Rome such as, the Trevi Fountain, Piazza Navona, Basilica of St. John Lateran and St. Mary Major.
- Dinner and overnight in Rome

Day 3: Rome - Assisi

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Check out of hotel and depart Rome for Assisi.
- Check in to your hotel upon arrival.
- Lunch on your own.
- Enjoy walking tour of Assisi including Basilica of St. Francis, Church of St. Chiara, San Rufino Cathedral, Rocca Maggiore Castle and Piazza del Commune.
- Dinner and overnight in Assisi

Day 4: Assisi - Venice

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Early departure for Venice.
- Lunch on your own en route.
- Enjoy a sightseeing of the city. Start the visit on the Mark's Square, Visit St. Mark's Basilica, Palace of the Doges, and The Bridge of Sighs.
- Dinner and overnight in Venice

Day 5: Venice - Salzburg

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Check out of hotel and depart for Salzburg, the lovely birthplace of Mozart, Salzburg the city of great houses, mansions, Festival Hall, and the Mirabelle Gardens. Hear the bells of the great Glockenspiel Tower, performed to a melody of Mozart's.
- Lunch on your own en route.
- Check in to your hotel upon arrival.
- Dinner and overnight in Salzburg

Day 6: Salzburg

- Breakfast at the hotel
- This morning you will have a guided tour of Salzburg's sights along Getreidegasse, the city's pedestrian street, lined with authentic 17th and 18th century buildings including the house where Mozart was born. View Monchsberg with the fortress "Hohensalzburg," which overlooks the



city. Built into the side of Monchsberg is the Salzburg Festspielhaus, home of the famous Salzburg Festival Operas. See Residenzplatz, the center square of Salzburg, dominated by the dynamic sculpture of the Residenzbrunnen, the largest Baroque fountain north of the Alps. The Residenz building, built in 1596, was once the palace of the Bishops. Nearby stands the Cathedral dating from 1614. Next, visit St. Peter's Abbey, next to the cemetery portrayed in the film The Sound of Music and where most of Mozart's religious works are premiered.

- Lunch on your own.
- Enjoy the Sound of Music tour. Drive along the Austrian Lake District, with marvelous views of the Salzkammergut Region. Visit Mondsee to reflect at this delightful resort, where, in the movie, Maria and the Baron were married. Then, continue to St. Gilgen on Lake Wolfgang, which offers one of the best-known landscapes of the Salzkammergut and the namesake fountain recalls the family connection of Mozart with this favored land. Visit St Wolfgang at Lake Wolfgang, the major sight is the pilgrimage church, built in the 14th and 15th centuries.
- Return to Salzburg.
- Dinner and overnight in Salzburg

Day 7: Salzburg - Oberammergau

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Check out of hotel and depart for Oberammergau.
- Lunch on your own.
- Arrival Oberammergau. The history of the passion play at Oberammergau goes back to the year 1634, when the quaint alpine village of Oberammergau was threatened by the deadly and contagious disease known as the Black Plague that scourged Europe, killing two-thirds of the population of Germany. The people of Oberammergau vowed that if the village could be spared, a re-enactment of the life and suffering of Christ would be performed. The village was miraculously saved from the ravages of the Black Death. Since that date, the play has been performed every ten years
- Dinner and overnight in Oberammergau or its vicinity

Day 8: Oberammergau

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Morning at leisure in Oberammergau village
- Lunch included



- After lunch take seats in the theatre to attend the performance of the world-famous passion play. This Play is performed by local villagers often roles are handed down from generation to generation within families. Dinner is included during a three-hour break in the late afternoon and the performance lasts until 10:30 pm.
- Overnight at the hotel in Oberammergau or vicinity

Day 9: Oberammergau – Munich

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Board the coach and depart for Munich, check into our hotel upon arrival.
- Ave some free time for lunch on your own.
- Enjoy guided tour of Munich. Begin with a visit to the Marienplatz with the world famous "Glockenspiel", and the twin-towered Frauenkirche, the most familiar landmark of old Munich. Continue on to see the Asamkirche, dedicated to the martyr St. John Nepomuk. You will see the town hall, and the magnificent boulevard Feldherrenhalle Ludwigsstrasse Siegestor, created by King Ludwig I in the middle of the 19th century. See the Residenz, the palace of the kings of Bavaria, and the Hofgarten.
- Dinner and overnight in Munich

Day 10: Munich departure

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Check out your hotel and transfer to Munich International Airport for your flight back home.
